The **CENTRAL EUROPEAN Transnational Program** promotes regional cooperation among Central-European countries during the programming period of 2014-2020.

The Central-European Program refers to nine countries. All the regions of seven EU member countries (Austria; Croatia; Czech Republic; Poland; Slovak Republic; Slovenia; and Hungary) take part in the program, while in case of two member countries (Germany and Italy) just only a few regions. Cooperation possibilities move on along four priority axes.

The priority axis No. 3 is “Cooperation in the field of natural and cultural resources in the favour of producing continuous growth in CENTRAL EUROPE”.

This priority deals with the demands connected with protection and sustainable use of cultural heritage and natural resources. The heritage and resources mean important value in Central-European region which as local factors contribute to the regional development. The program also brings into focus the environmental qualitative development of functional urban regions.

These developments will have direct effects on the urban quality of life.

As a joint application possibility from the required three specific objectives the promoted project inside the priority could aim at as follows: “Capacity development in favour of sustainable using cultural heritage and resources”.

Recommended condition to participating in the competition is 8-10 partners from 4-5 countries.

Recommended period of time for the project is 24 – 36 months.

The full budget of the project is 1 – 5 million Euros.
